


Overview of Portal 2

ILIAS

- Central place to access your course materials
 - However not used by all lecturers ℬ, see information in your first lecture of the course
- Access course materials as slides, recordings, papers, etc.
- Often includes a forum where you can ask questions about the course content
- Registering for an ILIAS course can be done via Portal 2 (see previous slide) or by searching for it in ILIAS

Events and Cooperations

We organize several events during the year. Each member of the FIM is allowed to bring new ideas and create new events.

Schneckenhof

The Schneckenhof is the event location of the university. Every students' association organizes a big party there each semester. Your first "Hof" will be in March.

Freshmen Days

The freshmen days are your start into your studies. We do our best to give you a balanced mixture of preparation for your degree and socializing events.

Freshmen Camp

Department's BBQ


The Department's BBQ is hosted by the department and the FIM at the end of the spring term. You have the opportunity to talk to your fellow students and professors over food and drinks.
